Proposed Amendments to Air Quality Regulations and the State Implementation Plan
 (25 Pa. Code, Chapter 126)
 Pennsylvania Clean Vehicles Program

The Environmental Quality Board (EQB) will hold three public hearings to accept comments on a proposal to amend 25 Pa. Code, Chapter 126, Subchapter D (relating to new motor vehicle emissions control program). The amendments propose to postpone the compliance date from model year (MY) 2006 to MY 2008 and update definitions in Section 121.1 (relating to definitions) for terms that are used in the substantive provisions in Chapter 126, Subchapter D. The amendments also propose to clarify the Pennsylvania Clean Vehicles Program in Chapter 126, Subchapter D and to specify in that subchapter a transition mechanism for compliance with the Pennsylvania Clean Vehicles Program.

The regulation, if approved, will be submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) as a revision to the State Implementation Plan (SIP). The SIP, which is a requirement of the Clean Air Act, is a plan that provides for the implementation, maintenance and enforcement of the National Ambient Air Quality Standard.
