

Driving PA Forward

- Over \$118M from Volkswagen Trust
- Beneficiary Mitigation Plan – PA’s strategy to achieve NOx reduction via transportation sector projects
- 8 funding programs, including 2 for light duty zero emission vehicle infrastructure



Level 2 Rebate Program

- \$3,000,000 available for Level 2 EV charging projects located at:
 - Public spaces
 - Work places
 - Multi-unit dwellings
- Application period now through 3/31/19 or until \$3M awarded
- Voucher system – must apply prior to project installation
- First come, first served
- Voucher issued for accepted projects – valid 180 days
- Voucher identifies maximum rebate level and exp. date

Level 2 Rebate Program

Rebate Levels: \$/plug or % of project cost, whichever is less

Table 1. Rebate Amounts for Projects on Government-Owned Property

<u>Project Type</u>	<u>Maximum Rebate per Plug</u>	<u>OR</u> <u>(whichever is less)</u>	<u>Maximum % of Total Project Cost</u>
Public Access, Networked	\$5,000	or	100%
Public Access, Non-Networked	\$5,000	or	90%
No Public Access	\$4,000	or	60%

Table 2. Rebate Amounts for Projects on Non-Government-Owned Property

<u>Project Type</u>	<u>Maximum Rebate per Plug</u>	<u>OR</u> <u>(whichever is less)</u>	<u>Maximum % of Total Project Cost</u>
Public Access, Networked	\$5,000	or	80%
Public Access, Non-Networked	\$5,000	or	70%
No Public Access	\$4,000	or	60%

Level 2 Rebate – Project Costs

- **Eligible**
 - Project design
 - EVSE purchase
 - EVSE installation
 - Electric service upgrades & connection
 - Networking charges (3 years max.)
 - Service contract (3 years max.)
 - Signs/lighting (public access projects)
- **Ineligible**
 - Permitting
 - Administrative
 - Electric supply
 - Real estate purchase/rental
 - Parking facility construction/maintenance

Level 2 Rebate Eligibility

- Eligible Locations
 - Government-owned property
 - Workplace property accessible to employees but not publicly accessible
 - Multi-unit dwelling (MUD) property accessible to residents but not publicly accessible
- Eligible applicants
 - Businesses
 - Non-profits
 - Governments
 - Transportation orgs.
- Eligible equipment
 - Level 2 EVSE
 - Minimum 208/240V @ 30A per plug
 - Minimum 2 plugs per project
 - J1772 standard plugs

Level 2 Rebate Program

- Projects quotes/detailed estimates required for application
- Apply online through eGrants only
- One application per site, multiple applications accepted
 - Max. \$100,000 in vouchers at a time for an applicant
- Projects operational for at least 3 years
- Annual performance reporting for 3 years
- Voucher redemption process online
 - Invoices and proof of payment required
