Dear Ms. Miller:

The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the above referenced application for an Individual Erosion and Sediment Control Permit and has determined that it is incomplete. The list below specifies the items that must be included in the resubmittal of your application and/or the submission of additional information. The *Pennsylvania Erosion and Sediment Pollution Control Program Manual* (E&S Manual) and the *Pennsylvania Stormwater Best Management Practices Manual* (BMP Manual) include information that may aid you in responding to some of the items listed below. The items are based on applicable laws and regulations, and the guidance sets forth the DEP's preferred means of satisfying the applicable regulatory requirements.

Please note that pursuant to 25 Pa. Code § 102.6(c)(2), this information must be received within 60 calendar days by 60 days from date of letter or DEP may consider the application withdrawn.

Items for Resubmittal or Submission of Additional Information

The following comments are from the York County Conservation District:

PNDI §102.6(a)(2)

1. The PNDI Avoidance Measures provided on the E&S and PCSM Plan drawings do not succinctly indicate when tree cutting may or may not occur.

Existing topographic features of the project site and the immediate surrounding area §102.4(b)(5)(i)

2. The Counties are not correctly identified on the E&S Plan drawings (ex. Sheets 2 & 23).

Supporting calculations and measurements §102.4(b)(5)(viii)

3. Standard E&S Worksheet #1 Compost Filter Socks provided in the Appendix A is not adequate (ex. right side of pages cut off).

Existing topographic features of the project site and the immediate surrounding area §102.8(f)(1)

4. The Counties are not correctly identified on the PCSM Plan drawings (ex. Sheet 2).

Net change in volume and rate of stormwater §102.8(f)(4)

5. Pre-development and post-development drainage area maps have not been provided for the PCSM SCM (ex. Infiltration Berm).
6. A Point of Discharge from the PCSM SCM has not been provided on the PCSM Plan or drainage area maps.

Supporting calculations §102.8(f)(8)

7. The DEP PSCM Spreadsheet provided is not adequate (ex. General Information page not included, provided pages cut off/missing information).

The following comments are from the Adams County Conservation District:

8. The Erosion and Sediment Control Plan mapping sheet has an E&S Best Management Practice that is called out as “Temporary Waterbar” but the detail has not been provided on the detail sheets that is titled as a “Temporary Waterbar”. *[25 Pa. Code §102.4(b)(5)(ix)]*

As stipulated in 25 Pa. Code § 102.6(c)(2) of DEP’s Chapter 102 rules and regulations (regarding complete applications), information requested by this office must be received within sixty (60) calendar days from the date of this letter, or DEP may consider the application to be withdrawn by the applicant and no further action will be taken. Fees are not refunded when an application is withdrawn.


Please submit 2 copies of the revised information to the York County Conservation District at 2401 Pleasant Valley Road, York, PA 17402, and Adams County Conservation District at 670 Old Harrisburg Road, Suite 201, Gettysburg, PA 17325, and an electronic copy of the revised information to DEP via Public Upload.
