Please be advised that if any other permits are required for this project, they must be issued prior to undertaking the activities described in those permit applications. Issuance of the enclosed permit(s) does not indicate an affirmative action on any other pending or future permit applications.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board) pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:
