The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) completed its review of the Closure Report for the Temporary Ash Disposal Site at Homer City Generating Station. The report certifies that approximately 444,274 cubic yards of ash and visibly impacted soil covering approximately 12 acres were excavated from the Temporary Ash Disposal Site and placed in the permitted Coal Refuse Disposal Area. The report documents this was done according to the plans, statements, documents, and designs submitted as part of the Temporary Ash Disposal Closure Plan as approved by the Department in July 2024.
