Enclosed is a permit modification to Solid Waste Permit No. 300491 for the operation of Homer City Generation, L.P. – Homer City Ash Disposal Site issued in accordance with Article V of the Solid Waste Management Act, 35 P.S. Sections § 6018.101, et seq.

This modification approves the following:

This permit is modified in accordance with the Minor Permit Modification entitled, “Minor Permit Modification – Stage IV Permit Revision.” The application was received on June 19, 2026. The modification removes the previously approved Stage IV area permitted on January 8, 2020. The permitted area reverts to the permitted area approved on October 12, 2012, which covers 243.7 acres. Leachate sampling will continue to be conducted at AVT-01.

As a result of this Minor Permit Modification, Homer City Generation, L.P. permit issued January 8, 2020, has been modified.

Please add the attached Form 13-A to your operating permit. Please note that the original operating permit expiration date of January 8, 2030, remains unchanged.

Compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in the permit are mandatory. Please note that issuance of this plan does not eliminate the necessity to comply with all federal, state, or local requirements at the facility.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S.A. Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, 400 Market Street, P.O. Box 8457, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, 717.787.3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800.654.5984. Appeals must

be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure may be obtained from the Board. The appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure are also available in braille or on audiotape from the Secretary to the Board at 717.787.3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST REACH THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS. YOU DO NOT NEED A LAWYER TO FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE BOARD.
