MODIFICATION TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND/OR PROCESSING
PERMIT**

Under the provisions of Act 97, the Pennsylvania Solid Waste Management Act, the Act of July 7, 1980, P.L. 380, 35 P.S. §§ 6018.101, et seq., Solid Waste Permit Number 300491 issued on January 8, 2020 to Homer City Generation, LP 1750 Power Plant Road, Homer City, PA 15748 for operation of the Homer City Station Ash Disposal Site Landfill located in Center and Black Townships, Indiana County is hereby modified as follows:

1. This permit modifies Solid Waste Permit No. 300491 originally issued on March 26, 1997. It is issued in response to Solid Waste Management Application No. 1164684 dated June 19, 2026, and designated as Authorization Request No. 1573745 for the revision of Stage IV and the reduction in permitted area of the Homer City Ash Disposal Site to the permitted area previously approved on October 12, 2012. The plans and specifications in the application are approved by the Department and are enforceable as a part of this permit modification.

This permit modification is issued based on the assumption that the information submitted in Solid Waste Management Permit Application No. 1164684, designated as Authorization Request No. 1573745, referenced in Permit Condition No. 2 are accurate. Any inaccuracies found in this information may be grounds for the revocation or modification of this permit and potential enforcement action.

This modification shall be attached to the existing Solid Waste Permit described above and shall become a part thereof effective on **August 4, 2026**.

3. Monitoring wells MP-31 and MP-35 shall be decommissioned/abandoned in accordance with the applicable requirements of PADEP March 27, 2021, Technical Guidance Document 261-02000-101, Appendix A. A Pennsylvania licensed professional geologist shall certify that the well abandonment/plugging activities comply with all applicable requirements. All relevant abandonment documentation, along with a description of the work completed, shall be submitted to the Department and any other required office. Department shall be notified at least 10 days prior to the commencement of field abandonment activities.
