In accordance with 25 Pa. Code 127.208(2), Perdue AgriBusiness LLC requests the transfer and use of 268 TPY of VOC emission reduction credits for offset purposes associated with its operation of a Soybean Processing Facility to be located in Lancaster County at 1897 River Road Marietta, PA 17547. Per Section C, Condition # 021(b) of Plan Approval 36-05158A, the emission reduction credits were procured from the following sources as described below:

In accordance with 25 Pa. Code 127.208(2), Perdue AgriBusiness LLC requests the transfer and use of 94 TPY of VOC emission reduction credits registered with the Maryland Department of the Environment for offset purposes from Element Markets, LLC to Perdue AgriBusiness LLC. The 94 TPY of VOC ERCs previously registered to GST Auto Leather, Inc. of Washington County Maryland were generated from the shutdown of the Garden State Tanning Facility on January 1, 2007. The request was made to transfer these credits to Plan Approval 36-05158A on June 13, 2016.

In accordance with 25 Pa. Code 127.208(2), Perdue AgriBusiness LLC requests the transfer and use of 174 TPY of VOC emission reduction credits registered with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation for offset purposes from Element Markets, LLC to Perdue AgriBusiness LLC. The 174 TPY of VOC ERCs previously registered to Bush Industries of Little Valley, New York located in the NE Ozone Transport Region were generated from the over – control of sources associated with this operation in May 1992. The request was made to transfer these credits to Plan Approval 36-05158A on June 13, 2016.




