To Whom It May Concern:

On September 14, 2018, ENERCON personnel, on behalf of Exelon, completed an environmental field review for an approximately 5.0 acre site for an Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) in Londonderry Township, Dauphin County, PA. The purpose of the field review was to identify the presence or absence of environmental features considered to be potentially jurisdictional under the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection and the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Such features include streams and wetlands.

During the environmental field review, ENERCON personnel observed the site area surface consists of gravel parking and concrete pads from former structures that have been demolished. We did not identify any environmental features that could be considered jurisdictional. Photographs of the subject property and existing structures are attached below.
