The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has completed its review of the permit applications submitted to DEP by Eastern Metal Recycling (EMR), formerly known as Camden Iron and Metal, for its proposed metals recycling facility in Eddystone Borough, Delaware County.

We have determined that the proposal meets all of DEP's applicable regulations and permit requirements, and the following permits for the project are being approved today:

- Air Plan Approval 23-0115
- Individual NPDES Permit (Construction Activities)
- Individual NPDES Permit PA0244562 for Discharge of Stormwater from Industrial Activities
- Water Obstruction and Encroachment No. E23-488


