DEP reviews the contents of the application to make sure that it is administratively complete.

- Correct and complete application
- General information form
- Compliance review form
- Municipal & county notification
- Best available technology or best achievable control technology
- Air quality analysis
- Additional impact analysis

# Administrative Review: What does this mean?

## Correct & Complete Application

- Correct application type was selected and completed with the respective fee

## General Information Form

- This form identifies if any additional permits from other DEP programs are needed for the project in order to facilitate program coordination

## Compliance Review Form

- This provides the name of the owner/operator and its associated facilities within Pennsylvania and their compliance status

## Notices informing the municipality and county

- This informs the municipality and county of the proposed project

# Administrative Review: What does this mean?

Best Available Technology  
or Best Achievable Control  
Technology

- This is to show the emission of the air pollutants are controlled to the maximum extent

Air Quality Analysis

- This is to ensure that the proposed emissions from the project do not violate any National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) or Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) increments
  - PSD Increment is the allowable emission increase that will prevent the air quality from deteriorating

Additional Impact analysis

- This is to ensure the proposed emissions from the project do not impact the quality of the ground, water, soil, vegetation as well as visibility

# Permit Review Process: Technical Review

- **Permit review**
  - New Source Review Applicability Determination
  - Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) Applicability Determination
  - Implement conditions and emission limitations to assure the proper operation of the source and minimize air emissions
  - Address all comments
- **Modeling review**
  - Air Quality Analysis
  - Additional Impact Analysis
  - Address all comments

# Time Frame

## Administrative Completeness Review

- 30 days from the date of receipt

## Technical Review

- Approximately one year

## Publication of draft decision

- Company/public review - 30 days from the date of publication
- EPA review – 45 days from the date of publication
- Public Hearing – approximately 30 days from the date of publication
- Comment period – beginning with date of publication and ending approximately 10 days after the scheduled hearing

## Address all concerns and prepare for final action
