Hello,

You are receiving this email from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) because you have expressed interest in the Rock Hill Quarry in East Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

As of September 14, 2022, mining and related activities remain under a cessation order.

This email is to provide notice that Hanson personnel are scheduled to be on site Tuesday September 20, 2022 to conduct Activity Based Sampling events 2 and 5 (equipment delivery and site maintenance activities).

For this sampling event, two pieces of equipment will be delivered and operated on site. After the event is completed, the equipment will be stored overnight outside of the quarry until the next morning. A smartphone based app will be used to create a track of the equipment utilized for this limited activity event. Low rate air sampling at all eight sampling points will likely begin between 7:00 and 8:00 am and will continue throughout the day. Higher rate air sampling will likely begin at all eight sampling points between 9:00 and 10:00 am and will continue (approximately 4 hours) for the duration of the activity.

PADEP Air Quality and Surface Mining Inspectors will be onsite for the duration of the sampling event.
