Hanson Aggregates Pennsylvania LLC (Hanson) is submitting this Corrective Action Plan in response to the Department's Mining Activities Inspection Report from the February 20, 2020 site visit (attached). Page 2 of the inspection report provides details of the Notice of Violation (NOV), including the following description:

The Department was notified via a complaint about activity on the site on February 20, 2020. The permittee Hanson Aggregates contacted the Department as well and stated that its employees were sent to the site to mark the property boundary on Rockhill Road. Hanson stated that its employees sent to the site were unaware of the cease order placed on activity at the site. The employees used one front-end loader to haul a bucket of screenings to the entrance and fill barrels placed along Rockhill Road. This is a violation of the cease orders issued in an email dated December 5, 2018 to Mr. Andrew Gutshall from Mr. Michael Menghini and also noted in an inspection report dated 9/16/2019 that there was to be no activity on the site without Department approval. Therefore a Notice of Violation is issued. (Continued in General Comments Section)

Hanson Aggregates and R.E. Pierson jointly will submit a corrective action plan detailing the following: the manner in which the Department will be notified prior to any site activity undertaken by Hanson, R.E. Pierson, or any person or entity activing on their behalf; any information providing notice to Hanson or R.E. Pierson employees regarding cessation activities on the site; safety measures to be implemented by Hanson or R.E. Pierson before any activity is to be conducted on site. The corrective action plan is to be submitted to Mr. Gary Latsha, DEP District Mining Manager in the Pottsville District Mining Office, no later than 8 am on March 16, 2020.

Corrective Action Plan

Activity Notification

Hanson, R.E. Pierson or any person / entity acting on their behalf will notify the Department by email, and receive approval, prior to the movement or removal of any aggregate or equipment on the site. Prior to regular site visits, such as NPDES sample collection or routine site inspections, Hanson, R.E. Pierson or any person / entity acting on their behalf will notify the assigned Surface Mine Conservation Inspector via email, text or phone call.

Employee Notice

Hanson recently provided written notification to employees at another Hanson facility nearby Rock Hill Quarry. A copy of the email is attached.

Safety Measures

Hanson, R.E. Pierson or any person / entity acting on their behalf will abide by a 15 miles per hour (mph) speed limit at the site. Any additional safety measures will be detailed in the written request as part of the Activity Notification (above).

On December 5, 2018, and September 16, 2019, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) issued a cease orders for the Rock Hill Quarry facility. The relevant text of those communications are included below for reference.

Please review the PADEP instructions below with all of your employees. In addition, no Hanson employees from your location should attempt to access the Rock Hill Quarry facility unless they have received permission from either:

At the current time, Hanson must notify the PADEP and receive approval prior to the movement or removal of any aggregate or equipment on the site. Only the three (3) individuals listed above should be in contact with PADEP.

PADEP Cease Order Details

December 5, 2018 email from Pottsville District Mining Manager Mr. Michael Menghini

Based on our earlier conversation related to the recent positive asbestos sampling result: the Department is hereby immediately ceasing mining and rock crushing-sizing at the Rock Hill Quarry at this time. The mining and rock crushing-sizing cessation will remain in effect until rescinded by the Department in writing.
