Enclosed, please find the Title V Operating Permit Minor Modification, and Administrative Amendment, for 23-00119 located in Marcus Hook Borough, Delaware County. All monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting requirements shall begin on the effective date. Please include the permit number above with any correspondence to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) concerning this Operating Permit.

The operating permit is being modified to address a decrease in the long-term permitted limit of carbon monoxide (CO) emissions from the three (3) auxiliary boilers (Sources 031, 033, and 034).

Additionally, this permit is amended to incorporate Plan Approval Number 23-0119H into the Title V Operating Permit.:

Condition No. 024 of the General Title V Requirements, Section B of the subject Operating Permit requires you to submit the annual compliance certifications (the appropriate form will be forwarded to your attention electronically) to the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Administrator as well as to DEP. The appropriate addresses are as follows:

- Restrictions
- Testing Restrictions
- Monitoring Requirements
- Recordkeeping Requirements
- Reporting Requirements
- Work Practice Standards
- Compliance Certification

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. Section 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S. Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, 400 Market Street, PO Box 8457, Harrisburg, PA 17105-8457, 717.787.3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800.654.5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure may be obtained from the Board. The appeal form and the Board's rules of practice and procedure are also available in braille or on audiotape from the Secretary to the Board at 717.787.3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.

IF YOU WANT TO CHALLENGE THIS ACTION, YOUR APPEAL MUST REACH THE BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS. YOU DO NOT NEED A LAWYER TO FILE AN APPEAL WITH THE BOARD.

IMPORTANT LEGAL RIGHTS ARE AT STAKE, HOWEVER, SO YOU SHOULD SHOW THIS DOCUMENT TO A LAWYER AT ONCE. IF YOU CANNOT AFFORD A LAWYER, YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR FREE PRO BONO REPRESENTATION. CALL THE SECRETARY TO THE BOARD (717.787.3483) FOR MORE INFORMATION.
