The primary and secondary crushing/screening plants were running. One front-end loader and three haul trucks were working on the 4th level. One drill was idle on the 1st level. One front-end loader was working in the stock area. One frontend loader and two haul trucks were moving material from the NE side of the stock area to the NW corner for reclamation. One dozer was working on the top level W side pushing material into the pit for reclamation. Mr. Phillips (Co-Superintendent) and I discussed cutting small openings in the haul road berms to allow for drainage. Photos were not taken at the ramp location due to employees working in that area. The employee log book was reviewed. Pumping volumes were reviewed and were approximately 500,000 GPD. Water was discharging and appeared clear. Water was covering the entire floor. The estimated water level on the floor is -83 MSL. The operator is reminded to submit the monthly truck count and estimated volume of material used for reclamation by the 5th of each month. The operator was reminded to have the reclamation hours and volumes in the guarterly report. The operator was reminded that reclamation work needed to continue as noted in items 2 and 3 in the Department letter dated January 29, 2016. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the January 29, 2016 letter will result in enforcement action.
