This partial inspection was conducted in the company of Mr. Tim Romano (Superintendent). The crushing/screening plants were not running due to a maintenance issue. Employees were working on the plant and would resume reclamation activities once the problem was fixed. One front-end loader was working in the stock area. One drill was working on the 3rd level. Pumping volumes were noted as lower than 500,000 GPD. Volumes were as low as 280,000 GPD. Some work was done on the inlet area. More material was pushed over the on the north wall. Stream work began on 7/29/2017 but was minimal due to the weather. I asked Mr. Romano to take some photos of the work and forward them to me. Water was discharging and clear. The water level was approximately -44 MSL.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal, pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. Section 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa. C.S. Chapter 5A, to the Environmental Hearing Board, Second Floor, Rachel Carson State Office Building, PA 17105-8457, Harrisburg, Box 8457. P.O. Street. 400 Market 717-787-3483. TDD users may contact the Board through the Pennsylvania Relay Service, 800-654-5984. Appeals must be filed with the Environmental Hearing Board within 30 days of receipt of written notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time period. Copies of the appeal may be obtained from the Board. At 717-787-3483. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.
