<u>Project Description</u> - The Borough of Harveys Lake and the Harveys Lake Environmental Advisory Council (EAC) were awarded a Growing Greener grant to treat approximately 210 acres of littoral shoreline for the longterm eradication program for the invasive plant hydrilla. The systemic herbicide SonarOne was used at a targeted dosage rate of 1-3 ppb, which kills the hydrilla but allows native species (like grassy pondweed and Vasey pondweed) to grow. The goal was to continue efforts to eradicate, or at a minimum control, the growth of hydrilla in Harveys Lake

Project Timeframe - December 07, 2017 through December 31, 2020

<u>Project Results</u> - The treatment was conducted in the summer of 2019 but matching funds through the Pennsylvania Lake Management Scoiety's mini-grant program provided additional funds to treat another 32 acres of littoral area. Thus, the 2019 treatment for hydrilla in Harveys Lake, targeted the lake's entire littoral zone of 242 acres

Project Costs - \$208,870 Growing Greener plus an additional \$141,370 in match funds.
