

**PROJECT SUMMARY**  
**Laurel Lick Run Stream Improvement Project**

**Project Description:** The Project will install fish enhancement structures to control stream bank erosion on the Laurel Lick Run for approximately 785 linear feet of stream.

**Project Goals:** The goals were to improve fish habitat and other aquatic resources while reducing sediment pollution from eroding streambanks into Laurel Lick Run.

**Project Results:** The streambanks were sloped and stabilized with 20 fish habitat structures which reduced sediment loading into the stream.
