

PROJECT SUMMARY

Nanty-Glo Flood Control Restoration Project – Phase II

Project Description: The Project will install fish enhancement structures to control stream bank erosion in the Nanty-Glo Flood Control Project Area.

Project Goals: The goals of the Project were to improve sediment transport through the flood control area while improving fish habitat and reducing sediment loading from eroded streambanks into the South Branch Blacklick Creek and an un-named tributary.

Project Results: A low flow meandering channel was constructed, fish habitat improved, streambanks stabilized and improvement in sediment transport obtained.
