Beacon Hill Stormwater Basin Retrofit Project Grant Document Number: C990002472 Lower Allen Township

Project Description

The basin retrofit at the Heights of Beacon Hill Subdivision addresses the stormwater issues for a drainage area of 21.5 acres, including 7 acres of impervious coverage. The retrofit converted a dry detention basin into a bioretention basin. Lower Allen Township is required to meet a 10% reduction in sediments over the next 5-year PAG-13 Permit Cycle. This retrofit also addresses non-point source pollution impairments of the Yellow Breeches Creek and the Susquehanna River.

Project Goals

The goals of this project included:

Reduction in Total Phosphorus, Total Nitrogen, and sediment; runoff control from small and frequent storms; managing non-point source pollution; vegetation act as a natural filter; maintenance requirements will be reduced with less mowing.

Project Results

The retrofit of the Heights of Beacon Hill Basin will reduce a total of 17,015.86 lbs/yr of sediment from reaching the Yellow Breeches, the Susquehanna River, and the Chesapeake Bay.
