NEAL RUN RESTORATION PROJECT – PHASE III

Project Summary





Location: Young Township, Indiana County, PA

<u>Project Description</u>: In 2011, marketable coal refuse was removed from the project site along with construction of oxidation and precipitation channels (OPC). These OPCs have removed up to 80% of the iron from the discharge; however, the concentrations are so high that a significant amount of pollutants remain. A 700-ton, limestone-only, Auto-Flushing Vertical Flow Pond (AFVFP) and a Settling Pond (SP) were added in Phase II of construction in 2018. In Phase III, a second AFVFP containing approximately 1,850 tons of high calcium carbonate (~90% CaCO3) AASHTO #1 limestone was constructed. The AFVFP flushes approximately every other day utilizing a solar-powered Agri Drain Automatic Water Level Control Structure into OPC1. Due to the heavily impacted water quality from the discharge, additional treatment components are still needed.

<u>Environmental Benefit</u>: The D2 discharge is the largest contributor of iron, aluminum, manganese, and acidity to the Aultmans Run Watershed. The source of the discharge is a large coal refuse pile upgradient of the project site. With the new AFVFP2, initial monitoring indicates that directly downstream of the treatment system at NL0-MP3, Neal Run is alkaline with varying amounts of metal solids dependent on the timing of the flush (see table below).
