# POLLUTANT REDUCTION PLAN IMPLEMENTATION GRANT DOCUMENT NO. C990002514 OHIO TOWNSHIP, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PA

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

As required by its Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Permit, Ohio Township must implement its Pollutant Reduction Plan to reduce the sediment loading reaching the Waters of the Commonwealth.

## PROJECT GOALS

To reduce the sediment loading as required by the MS4 Permit. The project is located within the Kilbuck Run – Ohio River, Lowries Run HUC-12 watershed.

#### PROJECT RESULTS

The project allowed for retrofitting of three existing stormwater basins. The retrofitted basins, located at Northridge Point, Northridge Crimson, and Heritage, has a sediment reduction of approximately 32,000 lbs/yr.
