PROJECT SUMMARY North Branch Blacklick Creek Stream Improvement Project Phase II

<u>Project Description</u>: The Project will consist of placing fish habitat enhancement structures along 480 feet of North Branch Blacklick Creek to stabilized streambanks and reduce sediment pollution.

<u>Project Goals</u>: The goals were to improve fish habitat and other aquatic resources while reducing sediment loading into the North Branch Blacklick Creek.

<u>Project Results</u>: A total of 19 structures were installed that included modified mudsills, log framed stone deflectors, log framed cross vanes, and random boulders which stabilized the eroding streambanks, improve fish habitat which in -return reduced sediment loading.
