



FieldDoc is a data management and reporting tool designed to assist with reporting and tracking of the Pennsylvania Phase 3 WIP and Countywide Action Plans (CAPs). Progress toward achieving each of the best management practice (BMP) goals identified in each respective CAP can be transparently tracked on its county page. FieldDoc will be an integrated tool that displays aggregated Hydrologic Unit Code (HUC) 12 data for tracking progress, from all state and federally reported data for each county. County Coordinators and those designated by the County Coordinator can report "unreported" BMPs for credit toward CAP goals.
