

## FY 2013 Coastal Zone Grants

---

### Delaware Estuary Coastal Zone

**13.PD.01: “Delaware Estuary Coastal Zone Management Implementation Program”**

Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission will use a \$50,000 grant to implement the Coastal Management Program in the Delaware Estuary Coastal Zone.

**13.PD.02: “Central Delaware Waterfront Regional Wetlands Park Design”**

Delaware River Waterfront Corporation will use a \$50,000 grant to create plans to transform Philadelphia’s formerly industrial riverfront between Piers 53 and 70 south into a wetlands education site.

**13.PD.03: “Freshwater Mussel Scientific Research and Community Involvement for Improved Water Quality in the Urban Pennsylvania Coastal Zone”**

Partnership for the Delaware Estuary, Inc. will use a \$49,425 grant to expand freshwater mussel restoration efforts through strengthening technical surveys and restoration planning for fresh water mussels in the Delaware River.

**13.PD.04: “ Schuylkill Banks South Street to Christian Street Construction “**

Philadelphia Parks and Recreation will use a \$60,000 grant to build a riverfront trail and greenway along the east bank of the Schuylkill River between South and Christian Streets in Philadelphia, extending the Schuylkill River Trail an additional 1,200 feet.

**13.PD.05: “Bristol Marsh Restoration, Stewardship, and Education”**

Heritage Conservancy will use a \$15,067 grant to enhance and protect ecological communities and endangered flora in Bristol Marsh.

**13.PD.06: “Restoration of Bartram's Garden”**

John Bartram Association will use a \$40,000 grant to create a plan to enhance and restore historic features that improve Bartram’s Garden as a regional cultural destination and public green resource on the banks of the Schuylkill River.

**13.PD.07: “2014 Southeastern PA Coast Day”**

Partnership for the Delaware Estuary, Inc. will use a \$30,000 grant to conduct Pennsylvania Coast Day 2014 events, which educate the public about coastal recreation, historic sites and public access.

**13.PD.08: “Delaware County Riverfront Resource Environmental Event 2014”**

Delaware County will use a \$6,500 grant for an interactive environmental education program as part of the annual Delaware County Riverfront Resource Environmental Event.

**13.PD.09: “ICC Coordination, Illegal Dump Cleanups, and Nonpoint Source Pollution Education Initiative in the Delaware Estuary”**

Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful will use a \$25,000 grant to plan, organize, oversee and report on the 2014 International Coastal Cleanup in Pennsylvania’s Delaware Estuary.

**13.PD.10: “Lardner's Park Composting Restroom”**

Fairmount Park Commission will use a \$50,000 grant to install a composting restroom at Lardner’s Point Park to serve current and future users and a future trail that will be part of the East Coast Greenway.

**Lake Erie Coastal Zone Projects**

**13.PE.01: “Lake Erie Coastal Zone Coordination & Technical Assistance”**

Erie County will use a \$71,000 grant for coordination and technical assistance with Lake Erie coastal zone projects.

**13.PE.01A: “Lake Erie Coastal Zone Administration of Bluff Recession Setback Act”**

Erie County will use a \$9,000 grant to administratively assist Lake Erie coastal communities required to administer bluff setback ordinances.

**13.PE.02: “ Lakeside Trail”**

Lawrence Park Township will use a \$21,500 grant to construct a 1,600-foot, ADA accessible trail from Lake Cliff Park to Lakeside Boat Launch/Beach.

**13.PE.03: “Liquid assets - protecting water resources by connecting citizens with local waterways”**

Erie Times-News in Education will use a \$38,760 grant for a recurring Newspaper in Education weekly page focusing on coastal zone environmental issues.

**13.PE.04: “City of Erie Comprehensive Plan Initiative - Phase II”**

Erie City will use a \$45,000 grant to complete Phase II of a comprehensive plan for the City of Erie.

**13.PE.05: “Master Site Plan for Headwaters Park”**

Erie County Conservation District will use a \$27,000 grant to develop a master site plan to provide guidance for the direction and future growth of Headwaters Park and its Best Management Practices (BMPs).

**13.PE.06: “McKean Area Comprehensive Plan”**

McKean Township will use a \$15,000 grant to update the McKean Area Comprehensive Plan with McKean Borough.

**13.PS.03: “Investigation of the Mortality of Angler Released Yellow Perch and Walleye in Pennsylvania Waters of Lake Erie”**

Regional Science Consortium will use a \$49,525 grant to quantify yellow perch and walleye mortalities through improved monitoring and recommended management strategies to reduce the mortality rate.

**Enhancement Grants Projects**

**13.EG.01-03: “Building Coastal Outreach Capacity in Pennsylvania”**

Pennsylvania State University, PA Sea Grant will use a \$80,000 grant to develop an aquatic invasive

species rapid response monitoring and surveillance system; build Marine Spatial Planning; and explore the Lake Erie coastal zone boundary and potential interests in expansion.

### **Coastal Nonpoint Pollution (CNPP) Projects**

#### **13.NP.01-03: ""Implementation of the Coastal Nonpoint Pollution Program"**

Bucks County Conservation District, Delaware County Conservation District, and Erie County Conservation District will each use a \$22,500 grant to implement and track coastal non-point pollution management measures.
