





Instructions on Downloading PA DEP Water Quality Network (WQN) data from EPA's Modernized STORET Database

1) Go to: http://www2.epa.gov/waterdata/storage-and-retrieval-and-water-quality-exchange, select the **Get Data** tab, scroll down to the **Download STORET Data** link.



- 2) When the new webpage opens, under <u>Geographic Location</u> choose, set Option A to **Pennsylvania** or leave the default **All**.
- 3) Under <u>Organization, Station, & Project</u>, choose Option 3 and set the <u>ORG ID</u> to **21PA_WQX** by using the Organization Name drop down box. Leave the <u>Search Type</u> defaulted to <u>Search by Station ID</u> and type **WQN0%** into the Search String box. Click <u>Search Stations</u>. A list of all WQN stations in the database will appear. Use <u>Ctrl</u> to select multiple stations. You can also enter the exact WQN number if you have a specific station you are interested in.
- 4) Under Station Type, leave the default as Select All
- 5) Under <u>Date, Administrative Filters</u>, set the Activity Start Date range for the period of interest or leave default.





- 6) Leave the Activity Medium and Activity Intent and Community Sampled as defaulted.
- 7) Under <u>Characteristic</u>, it is best to leave this blank so all parameters are pulled. A specific parameter can be chosen but be sure the correct Characteristic Name is used.
- 8) A specific Characteristic Group Type can be chosen or left blank.
- 9) Under <u>Data Download Report</u>, click **Result Download** to obtain your data. There are options to **exclude** certain data types or to only download station information.
- 10) A new results page will appear, before selecting *Immediate* or *Overnight Batch Processing*, scroll down and review the choices under *Select Data Elements for Report(s)*. Check *Station Name* in the left column and *Additional Anal Proc Info* in the center column. Other items can be selected; however, data may not be available for the WQN stations.
- 11) Follow the download instructions on the website.
