Summary of Review

On December 16, 2021, the Department received an application for Amendment to NPDES Permit PA0003603 from Universal Stainless & Alloy Products Inc. (USAP) for the facility located in Collier Township, Allegheny County. The NPDES Permit was recently renewed and issued on December 2, 2021.

USAP purchased the adjacent property, previously owned by Carpenter Powder Products, Inc., at 682 Mayer Street, Bridgeville PA 15017. The property has one (1) uncontaminated stormwater outfall, which is shared by USAP's existing Outfall 017. Currently, there is no equipment or materials on the property, so there is no industrial activities conducted.

The discharge from Outfall 017 consists of uncontaminated stormwater with a drainage area of 232,180 ft² of which 65% is impervious. The drainage area was 102,153 ft² and has been increased to include the newly acquired property. Outfall 017 is already captured in USAP's NPDES permit. Part C.III. Requirements Applicable to Stormwater Outfalls, Condition A will be revised to reflect the updated drainage area for Outfall 017.

On February 25, 2019, Quinten Cameron conducted a site inspection with no violations noted.

The facility has no open violations.

The Draft Amendment of the NPDES Permit is recommended to Universal Stainless & Alloy Products, Inc. The new NPDES Permit number is PA0003603 A-1.

Summary of Review

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
