Summary of Review

This amendment changes the effective date of the limitations for several parameters from November 1, 2021 to November 1, 2023. The new effective date coincides with the parameter effective dates in the facility's latest amended DRBC docket (D-1983-018-2). The limitations were originally added to the latest issued NPDES permit renewal as a result of the DRBC docket requirements in effect at the time. In addition, the permit template has been updated from the September 2016 version to the August 2021 version.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
