### Summary of Review

This is a DEP initiated amendment.

DEP operations staff and planning staff requested that the NPDES be amended to reflect the ability for the facility to comply with Chapter 94 requirements. Since the treatment plant receives wastewater from a municipality, the facility will be subject to Chapter 94 reporting.

The current permit does not include raw influent samples.

This permit amendment corrects the NPDES permit to include BOD and TSS raw influent samples.

#### Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.

As of March 2025, the facility has a pending open violation. The amended NPDES may be withheld until the open violation is remediated.
