Internal Review and Recommendations

Public notice was published in the PA Bulletin on July 27, 2019.

A comment letter dated August 26, 2019 from Global Companies, LLC was received on August 27, 2019. The letter offered the following comment:

“The draft permit identifies the facility as “Buckeye Terminals LLC Macungie Terminal.” The Buckeye Terminals LLC (Buckeye) reference appears to be a typographical error; Buckeye has no involvement in the operation or ownership of the facility. The previous permit for the facility correctly identifies the facility as “Global Companies Macungie Terminal”.

Response – The name of the facility was corrected to “Global Companies Macungie Terminal”. The facility is owned by Chelsea Sandwich, LLC and is operated by Global Companies, LLC.

A second draft is being issued for this facility because the first draft permit was mistakenly generated for an NPDES permit for stormwater associated with industrial activities. This second draft has been corrected and is for an NPDES permit for industrial wastewater facilities (which is consistent with the previous permit issued in 2013).

No limits or reporting frequencies have been changed. Special conditions for Petroleum Marketing Terminals are included in the permit, including authorization to discharge hydrostatic test water.
