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### Internal Review and Recommendations

The first draft of this application appeared in the PA Bulletin on Saturday, July 31, 2021. The final NPDES permit could not be issued at that time due to open violations.

One comment was received from the Clean Water Operations section during the public comment period:

**Comment** - On the bottom of Page 3 of the permit the annual E. Coli sample is listed to be taken as an 8-hour composite. I believe this sample should probably be a grab sample instead of a composite.

**Response** – *The E. coli required sampling type has been changed to Grab*

Modeling was not re-run.

Stormwater Outfall 002 in the first draft of the permit utilized monitoring requirements of the PAG-03 General Permit Appendix L and previous permit requirements. Please note that the Department renewed the NPDES General Permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity (PAG-03) and it became effective on March 24, 2023. Total Nitrogen monitoring/reporting has been added to the permit. All other parameters from Outfall 002 in the first draft permit were maintained in the second draft.

All the permit documents have been updated to the newest format, including the Part C.III. requirements applicable to stormwater outfalls.
