Internal Review and Recommendations

The City of Allentown MS4 is the only Phase 1 MS4 located within the DEP Northeast Region. Referencing demographic data dating back to 1980, the City has experienced steady growth. More recently, Allentown has seen rapid population growth in the period from 2000 to 2010 where the population increased from 106,632 to 118,032. The City is entirely within the urbanized regulated area. The MS4 discharges to the following Waters of the Commonwealth: Cedar Creek, Trout Creek, UNT to Lehigh River and Jordan Creek. Since the discharges are to special protection waters, this permit is an "individual permit".

In an effort to make the permit better reflect the intent of the current Pennsylvania MS4 program, a version of the previous permit was combined with Appendix A of the current PAg-13 permit which details the Stormwater Management Program.

The City MS4 does not discharge to the Chesapeake Bay Tributary Area and therefore will not need to submit a Chesapeake bay Pollution Prevention plan

The City does discharge to Little Cedar Creek, which does have a Department approved TMDL plan. The City has continued to provide TMDL plan information with each annual MS4 report submission. An initial TMDL Strategy will not be required, however, a formalized TMDL Design Details plan will need to be submitted within 12 months of the effective date of the permit renewal.
