**Summary of Review**

The applicant is requesting a renewal of their NPDES permit to discharge stormwater associated with industrial activity to an Unnamed Tributary to Monocacy Creek, a HQ-CWF, MF (High Quality-Cold Water Fishes, Migratory Fishes) designated receiving stream in state water plan basin 2-C (Lower Lehigh River). As per the Department's current existing use list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than its designated use.

The facility is categorized by SIC code 4213 (Transportation & Utilities – Trucking, Except Local) and falls under Appendix L monitoring requirements of the PAG-03 General Permit. Semiannual Monitoring / Reporting is for Total suspended solids (TSS), Total Nitrogen, Oil & Grease and Total Phosphorus. Benchmarks exist for TSS and Oil & Grease.

Benchmark values are not effluent limitations, and exceedances do not constitute permit violations. However, if the permittee's sampling demonstrates exceedances of benchmark values for two or more consecutive monitoring periods, the permittee shall take action in accordance with Part C. V. F. of the permit. A corrective action plan must be submitted to DEP if the discharge concentration for the parameters exceeds the benchmark values for two or more consecutive monitoring periods.

Previous limits for TSS and Oil & Grease are removed in this renewal permit due to change in the PAG03 General permit.

PPC Plan and annual Inspection are both requirements in this permit. Permittee is required to update the PPC plan annually or as necessary.

Last inspection was performed November 11, 2024 and found the following violations. Permittee has to address these violations before issuance of the final permit.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
