| Summary of Review |
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| <p>A first draft of this application appeared in the PA Bulletin on Saturday, May 2, 2020.</p> <p>The purpose of this second draft for Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc (APW) – Cove Village WWTP’s NPDES permit renewal is due to a comment letter from APW (attached). The letter is dated May 5, 2020 and was received by the Department via e-mail on May 4, 2020. The letter offered one comment for the Department’s consideration:</p> <p>Comment #1 requests that a period of four years (instead of one year) be granted for the facility to reach the technology based Total Residual Chlorine (TRC) limitations set in the draft permit. The permittee indicates that the additional time would allow them to perform a feasibility study to assess the best approach to meet the new TRC limits, prepare designs for any new facilities that may be required, submit a Water Quality Management permit for such new facilities, and complete the construction/ start-up of the new facilities.</p> <p><i>Response</i> – The Department has updated the draft permit to allow the facility four years to meet the technology-based TRC limitations.</p> <p> CommentLetter_Cove Village_5-4-2020.p</p> |

Summary of Review

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
