In accordance with your request received on April 27, 2022, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has transferred the above referenced permit(s). Please study the permit(s) carefully and direct any questions to this office.

The NPDES permit expires on the date identified on page 1 of the NPDES permit. If you intend to continue discharging beyond the permit expiration date, you must submit a complete application to renew your permit at least 180 days prior to the expiration date.

Enclosed are Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) templates and supplemental forms for your use in meeting the monitoring and reporting requirements of the permit. Your facility is registered to use DEP's electronic DMR (eDMR) system (see [www.dep.state.pa.us/edmr](http://www.dep.state.pa.us/edmr)). DEP expects that the use of eDMR will continue for the facility. Therefore, the paper DMRs and supplemental forms attached to the permit should be used only for backup purposes. Please contact DEP using the contact information listed on the eDMR website to add new personnel or modify existing eDMR account information.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board), pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:
