Summary of Review

The PA Department of Environmental Protection has received an NPDES permit transfer application from Pennsylvania American Water Company ("PAWC"). to transfer the Farmington Township STP Clarion from Farmington Township on October 1, 2024. The current NPDES permit was issued on April 27, 2023 which will expire on April 30, 2028. The transfer was due to change in ownership from Farmington Township to Pennsylvania American Water Company ("PAWC"). This transfer is a part of several other transfers from Farmington Township to Pennsylvania American Water Company ("PAWC") that include WQM Permit No. 1600408, WQG028301 and WQG028315.

There are 14 open violations in WMS for the subject Client ID (87712) as of November 12, 2024.

Note with this transfer, the facility will be changed from a Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTWs) to Non-Municipal Sewage Treatment Works. Due this change, the transfer will be processed as a Major Amendment, requiring the Permit to be Drafted and published in the PA Bulletin for comments. -AO

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
