Summary of Review

The permittee is applying for reissuance of Individual Permit No. PA0272558 that expired on January 31, 2025. The existing discharge serves a 3-bedroom home and discharges into Twomile Run (HQ-CWF).

The existing facility consists of (WQM Permit No. 6219413): A 1,000-gallon dual compartment concrete septic tank with an effluent filter followed by a Premier Tech EC7-500-C-P Coco filter with integral UV disinfection and effluent pumping.

Act 14 notifications were submitted and received.

There are no open violations in WMS for the subject Client ID (352753) as of April 2nd, 2025.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.

Other Comments: This SRSTP was designed where applicable in accordance with the SFTF Manual, but it does not qualify for the PAG-04 General Permit due to the use of a Premier Tech EC7-500-C-P Coco filter and the High Quality (HQ) stream designation.

In accordance with the SOP, water quality modeling was not performed since this is a SRSTP.

Proposed Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements

The limitations and monitoring requirements specified below are proposed for the draft permit, and reflect the most stringent limitations amongst technology, water quality and BPJ. Instantaneous Maximum (IMAX) limits are determined using multipliers of 2 (conventional pollutants) or 2.5 (toxic pollutants). Sample frequencies and types are derived from the "NPDES Permit Writer's Manual" (362-0400-001), SOPs and/or BPJ.

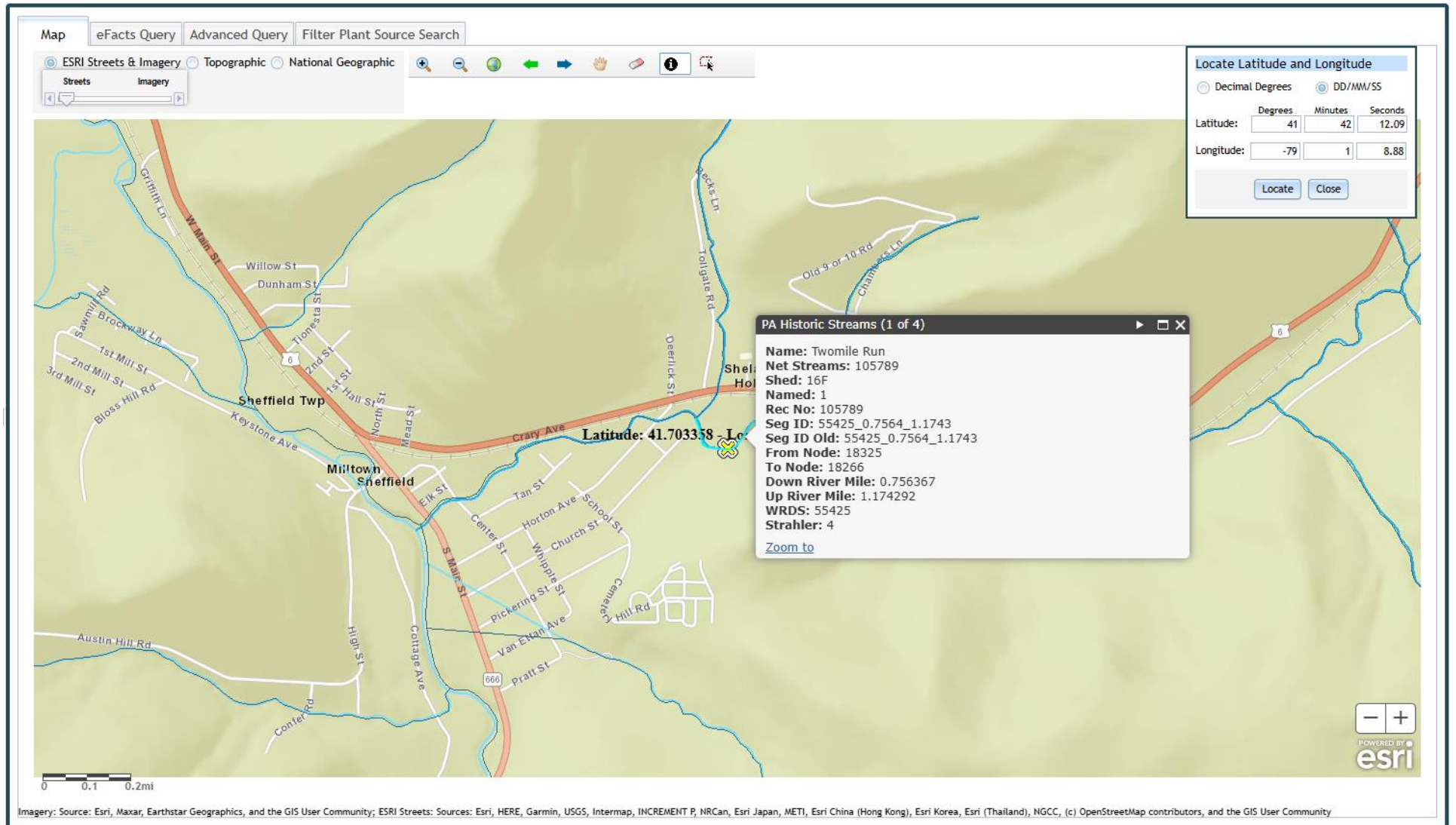

Other Comments: Flow is monitor only based on Chapter 92a.61. The limits for BOD₅, Total Suspended Solids, and Fecal Coliform are technology-based on Chapter 92a.47. The limits for pH are technology-based on Chapter 93.7 and, as a regional policy, the monitoring frequency has been established as "1/month" due to High Quality (HQ) stream designation.
