Summary of Review

The permittee is applying for reissuance of Individual Permit No. PA0272965 which would expire on August 31, 2025. The existing discharge serves a single home.

The existing facilities consist of (WQM Permit No. 3314401): A 1,000-gallon dual compartment septic tank, a 500-gallon dosing tank with pump, a recirculating subsurface sand filter, and an erosion feed chlorinator with a 500-gallon contact tank and dichlorination.

Act 14 notifications have been submitted and received.

There are no open violations in WMS for the subject Client ID (321065) as of March 5, 2025.

No AMRs were located. The permittee has been notified that AMRs should be submitted annually.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.

Proposed Effluent Limitations and Monitoring Requirements

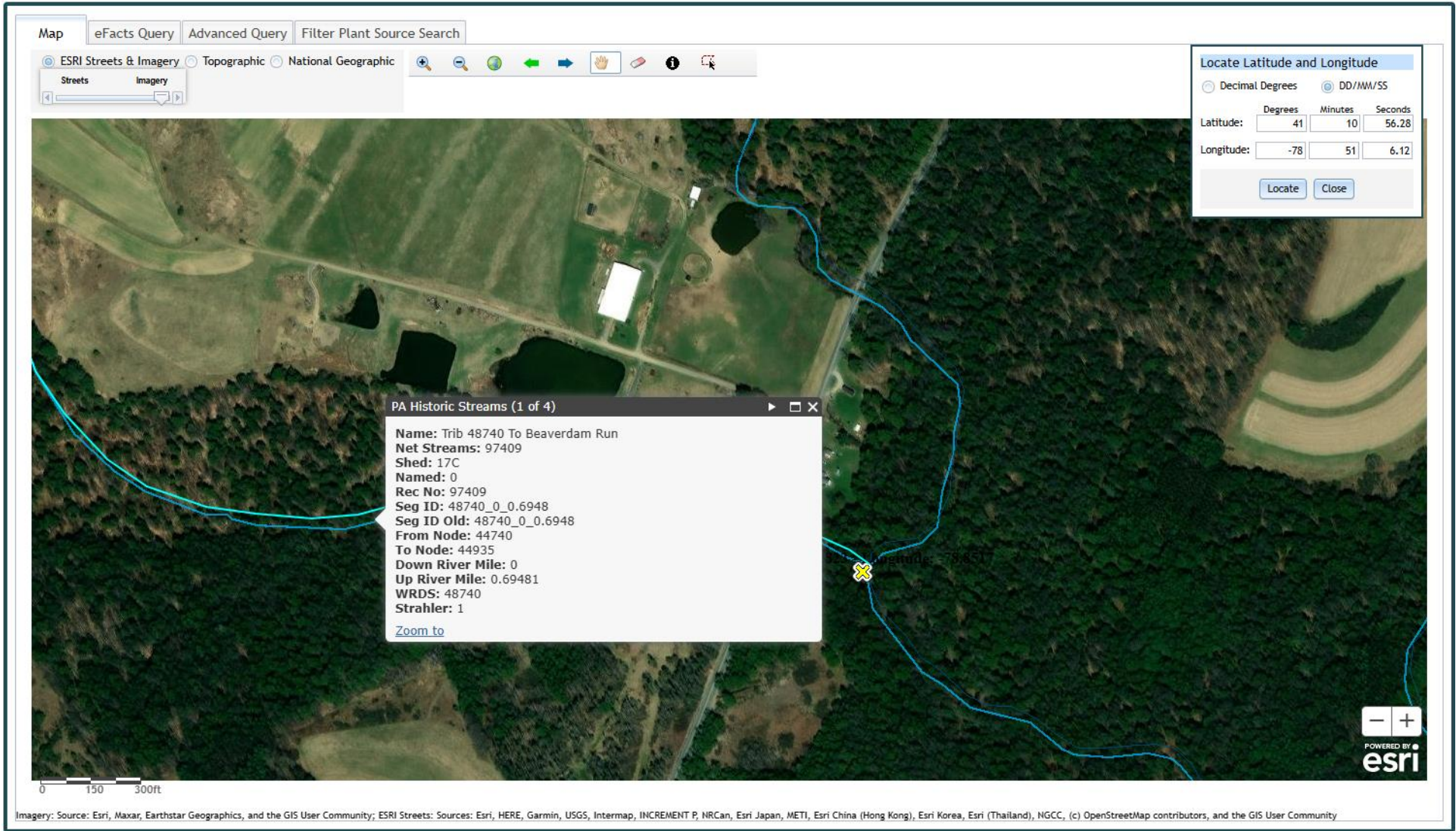
