**Summary of Review**

The applicant is requesting renewal of an NPDES permit to discharge stormwater associated with an industrial activity to Iron Run, a high quality, cold water fishery, migratory fishery-designated receiving stream (HQ-CWF, MF) in State Water Plan Basin 02-C. Per the Department's current existing use list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than the designated use. The discharge is not expected to affect public water supplies.

The facility is classified under SIC Code 2051 – Manufacturing – Food and Kindred Products. The PAG-03 General Permit Appendix I contains the site-specific best management practices (BMPs).

The facility has not discharged through its two Outfalls since it was constructed. Permittee is not required to do any sampling and reporting.

The applicant restated in this application that currently there is no discharge of stormwater from the two outfalls 001 and 002. The facility was constructed with best management practices that rely on infiltration basins and evapotranspiration

A compliance evaluation inspection was performed on November 11, 2024 and no Non-compliance were observed.

The inspection noticed the 3-rain gardens, and the 2 detention basins are routinely inspected. The site drainage area is free of any pollution or sediments.

A comprehensive Prevention and Preparedness Plan (PPC) was submitted with this application

**Public Participation**

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
