Summary of Review

The applicant is requesting a renewal NPDES permit for stormwater discharges associated with ~~facility-for-paint products/industrial activities.~~ ~~Stormwater Outfall 001 at exist of retention basin4B discharges runoff from the facility~~ into an ~~u~~Unnamed ~~T~~ributary to Lyon Run, a HQ-CWF receiving water. Per the Department's current existing use list, the receiving stream does not have an existing use classification that is more protective than the designated use ~~.~~ Lyon Creek is listed as impaired for natural sources but, cause of impairment is unknown. Stormwater sampling results sent ~~w~~
 With this application suggest that stormwater discharge from this facility is not expected to ~~cause-contribute to~~ any impairment.

The ~~facility~~is ~~a~~ regional storage and distribution center of ~~p~~Paint products ~~and no manufacturing occurs at this Behr facility.~~ ~~and is categorized by This facility~~ SIC Code is 4225 (General warehousing & storage) and falls under Appendix L monitoring requirements of PAG_03 General. Semiannual ~~m~~Monitoring /_reporting are required for Total Nitrogen, Total Phosphorus, Total Suspended Solids (TSS), and Oil & Grease.

Benchmark exist for (TSS), and Oil & Grease. Benchmarks are pollutant in stormwater discharges that serves as a threshold for the determination of whether existing site BMPs are effective in controlling stormwater pollution. The benchmark values can be found in Part C. V. F. of the permit. A corrective action plan must be submitted to DEP if the discharge concentration for the parameters exceed the benchmark values for two or more consecutive monitoring periods.

~~Since Benchmarks values cannot be used as permit limits anymore the limits for TSS and Oil & Grease are removed from the permit.~~

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
