**Internal Review and Recommendations**

The first PA public Notice was published On March 23, 2024 and as of today no comments were received.

During Field visit and inspection of the Facility stormwater conveyance on March 19, 2024 a major amendment to the existing permit was warranted and is summarized as follow:

Outfalls (**001, 002, 003**) in the existing permit are actual Inlets from relative drainage areas discharging into Detention Basin (BMP) therefore they cannot be considered Outfalls and they are unlinked and inactivated for this permit term.

Detention Basin Outfall Pipe is labeled **Outfall 004** (Lat: 40.57740; Long: -75.608850). It is linked to primary facility is The appropriate outfall and will be monitored and reported for eDMRs purposes.

During the inspection of the site It is noticed considerable amount of siltation deposits at the exit outfall pipe; the permittee is reminded to implement all necessary BMPs applicable and enhance the existing ones.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that
