Summary of Review

This is a redraft of PA0276979, which was posted on the PA Bulletin on October 11, 2025. One comment was received from the DEP Operations section, which is stated at the bottom of this summary and answered in **Bold**.

The following comments were received by the DEP Operations section and are answered below in **bold**.

1. The draft permit contains both a hard limit in Part A and a benchmark limit in Part C for the stormwater parameter pH at Outfalls 001 and 002. Please let us know if this was intentional and, if so, why pH is listed in Part A as an enforceable limit? Thank you.

The pH hard limits should not have been included and should have been removed when it was determined that ELG hard limits for TSS and pH were not applicable to the facility. The hard limit for pH has been removed and a redraft will be issued.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
