Summary of Review



The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) issued NPDES Permit No. PA0284921 A-1 on January 26, 2023. The amendment reflected the transfer from Mr. Brandon Riggle to Mr. Jason Sherry.

During the review for the permit transfer, it was noted that a Part C condition for monthly cleaning was omitted from the original permit. Adding the condition would not allow for public comment, therefore, the transfer permit was issued without change. DEP is initiating an amendment at this time to add Part C II. Ultraviolet (UV) Disinfection.

No other changes are being made to the permit at this time.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
