**Internal Review and Recommendations**

The applicant request renewal of an Individual NPDES permit to discharge from a small MS4.

According to the requirements, the permittee submitted a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Plan to address the Waste Load Allocation (WLA) in the "Total Maximum Daily Loads for Bacteria and Sediment in the Christine River Basin, Pennsylvania, Delaware, and Maryland" and "Revisions to Total Maximum Daily Loads for Nutrients and Low Dissolved Oxygen Under High-Flow Conditions Christian Basin, Pennsylvania, Delaware, and Maryland".

The permittee has a requirement for TMDL Plan-Siltation, Suspended Solids (4a) and TMDL Plan-Nutrients, Organic Enrichment/Low D.O. (4a) for the Christina River Basin.

Based on the review of the original application and TMDL Plan, DEP issued a comment letter on February 23, 2018.

Review of revised TMDL Plan received April 19, 2018 shows TMDL Plan is acceptable.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
