Internal Review and Recommendations

Newtown Township has submitted NPDES application for renewal of permit to discharge stormwater from small municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4). Previously, Newtown Township was covered under General Permit PAG130048. Newtown Township has submitted PRP Plan along with NPDES application. We approve this plan. Permittee shall implement Pollutant Control Measures for Pathogens under Appendix B of the permit. Township shall meet PRP requirements under Appendix E of the permit.

Technical review of the NPDES application was completed and letter with comments/recommendations for improvements was sent out to applicant on April 26, 2018. We received revisions to in response to these comments from Township's consultant on June 17, 2019.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
