Internal Review and Recommendations

This applicant has submitted a renewal MS4 Individual Permit Application Package containing TMDL/PRP for the coverage under the permit cycle 2018-2023. The previous permit was issued on 2/11/2013.

The township enacted a SWM Ordinance on February 10, 2014.

The applicant has indicated in the application that it will rely on Pennsylvania's Chapter 102 program for E & S controls and post-construction SWM requirements.

The review of TMDL/PRP is detailed in TMDL Plan Review Check List.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
