Internal Review and Recommendations

Project Manager Jim McTish initiated his review of this MS4 Permit application on Friday, January 1, 2022. Initially this permit application was assigned to Laurel Ateyeh then to James Roth. The previous engineers had not initiated a review of this application.

Within Worcester Township, there are three HUC 12 watersheds: 1. Stoney Creek; 2. Wissahickon creek; and 3. Skippack Creek.

Stoney Creek: Appendix E for both Sediment and Nutrients.

Wissahickon Creek: TMDL for Sediment

Skippack Creek: TMDL for Sediment and Appendix E for Nutrients.

Worcester Township is a member of the Skippack Creek Multi-Municipal Consortium which has addressed the Skippack Creek TMDL Plan.

On November 22, 2016 Worcester representatives including their Engineer, Mary Stover and Department staff including Pravin Patel, Keith Dudley, and Lee Murphy met in the Norristown's PA DEP office. During this meeting, it was agreed that since the Wissahickon Creek watershed within Worcester Township is so small, that the Township was not obligated to meet the Waste Load Allocation associated with the Wissahickon TMDL.

Internal Review and Recommendations

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
