Internal Review and Recommendations

Warwick Township has submitted application for renewal of NPDES permit for discharge of stormwater from MS4 into tributary of Neshaminy Creek, Little Neshaminy Creek and Neshaminy Creek. Previously, Warwick Township was covered under PAG130074 for discharge of stormwater from small municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4). Warwick Township has submitted PRP and TMDL Plan along with application. We approve both these plans. Township shall implement Pollutant Control Measures for Pathogens under Appendix B and Organic Compounds under Appendix C of the NPDES permit. Township shall also meet PRP requirements under Appendix E and TMDL requirements under Appendix F of the NPDES permit.

Technical review of the NPDES permit application was completed and letter with comments/recommendations for improvements was sent out to applicant on June 8, 2018. We received revisions in response to comments from Township's consultant on November 14, 2018.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
