Internal Review and Recommendations

The applicant requests approval for renewal of an NPDES permit to discharge stormwater form a Municipal Separate Strom Sewer System MS4. The system discharges to UNTs to E. Branch Brandywine Creek and Valley Creek.

TMDL – the permittee has no MS4 Outfalls located on a TMDL designated stream; however, UNT to E. Branch Brandywine Creek and Valley Creek are listed as impaired on the State's 303(d) list. The application indicates that the cause for impairment to UNT to E. Branch Brandywine Creek is unknown and the Valley Creek impairment is due to sediment.

Special Protection – Sections of the E. Branch Brandywine are listed as High Quality under 25 Pa. Code Chapter 93.

The application indicated that over that last 5 years the permittee was not in violation of any permits issued by PA DEP.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
