Internal Review and Recommendations

The applicant requests approval for renewal of an NPDES permit for the discharge of stormwater form a municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4).

TMDL- There are no TMDLs associated with this municipal boundary.

The permittee submitted an individual MS4 permit renewal application because South Coventry's MS4 system discharges to Pigeon Creek and French Creek which have a 25 Pa. Code, Chapter 93 designation of High Quality and Exceptional Value respectively.

On November 2, 2017, the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) received South Coventry Township's (Township) Individual Permit Application (IPA). The IPA does not include a request for a waiver of NPDES Small MS4 Permit Requirements.

Public Participation

DEP will publish notice of the receipt of the NPDES permit application and a tentative decision to issue the individual NPDES permit in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* in accordance with 25 Pa. Code § 92a.82. Upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, DEP will accept written comments from interested persons for a 30-day period (which may be extended for one additional 15-day period at DEP's discretion), which will be considered in making a final decision on the application. Any person may request or petition for a public hearing with respect to the application. A public hearing may be held if DEP determines that there is significant public interest in holding a hearing. If a hearing is held, notice of the hearing will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* at least 30 days prior to the hearing and in at least one newspaper of general circulation within the geographical area of the discharge.
